## PART 1: ISLAM

This course is an introduction to the history, institutions, beliefs and practices of Islam.

Special emphasis is placed on studying the life and ministry of Muhammad, the origin and theology of the Koran, hadith criticism and the development of Islamic jurisprudence, followed by an empathetic exploration of Islamic devotion and Sufism.

Finally, the course will examine how Islam and Christianity have interacted throughout history and what this means for Christian witness today.

## PART 2: BUDDHISM

An introduction to Buddhism from a historical and theological perspective that examines the central teachings of Buddhism, the nature of Buddhist spiritual practices and meditative experience in the context of East Asia.

The course will examine the historical origins of Buddhism arising from the life, ministry and thoughts of Buddha. It will also cover an introduction to Buddhist scriptures and major tenets of faith—Karma and rebirth; the Four Noble Truths—Nature and Origin of Suffering, Nirvana and the Path; the process of Buddhist meditation and goals of Buddhist enlightenment; the rise of Buddhist Theravada and Mahayana Schools; Modern Buddhism and the New Age Movements.

Finally, the course will provide a comparison with Christian beliefs and spiritual practices, as well as the challenges and prospects for Christian witness.

## ABOUT THE SPEAKER

**DR NG KAM WENG** Ph.D.

Dr Ng is the Research Director of Kairos Research Centre Malaysia. After his doctoral studies at Cambridge United Kingdom, he lectured on New Testament, Systematic Theology, Ethics and Philosophy and served as Dean of Graduate School at Malaysia Bible Seminary before assuming his current position at Kairos Research Centre.

He was a Fellow at the Centre for the Study of Christianity in Asia (CSCA) at Trinity Theological College and a Fellow at the Oxford Centre for Mission Studies. He is also a member of the Center of Theological Inquiry, Princeton.

Dr Ng is married to Tien Tien. They have two grown up children.
